It houses outpatient services, including chemotherapy, infusion therapy and radiation therapies.

Reporting to the Senior Vice President/Chief Nurse Executive, the Oncology Service Line Administrator provides strategic and operational leadership for the growth and development of NHRMC's Oncology program. The administrator will manage 45 FTEs and have specific departmental oversight of Radiation Oncology, Physician Office Practice (Surgical, Gyn and Medical Oncology) Infusion Unit, Cancer Research Program, Cancer Registry, and the Healing Arts Network, as well as indirect oversight for the inpatient oncology unit. The Oncology Administrator is responsible for leading the efforts to maintain accreditation by the American College of Surgeons, Commission on Cancer as a Community Cancer Program.
