Director Oncology Services

In collaboration with the designated Oncology Services Medical Director, supports oncology services advancement, development, refinement and growth. The Director, Oncology Services will direct, plan, market, and implement oncology services with direct responsibility for the overall staff of the cancer center in conjunction with the Medical Director. This includes the functions of PICC, outpatient infusion services, breast center, cancer prevention/outreach/screening programs, the cancer committee, tumor registry, tumor boards, disease site teams (DST), patient navigation (to include but not limited to navigation in nursing, ACS, financial and social work), genetic counseling, nutrition, research programs, survivorship programs, complementary/integrative medicine and the cancer center facilities with liaison/collaborative responsibility to private practice radiation and medical oncology. The Director will partner closely and have shared influence and responsibilities in the areas of marketing, fundraising, finance, GYN oncology, home health/hospice, pain management/palliative care areas, research and pediatric oncology.

Education and Experience: Master's degree in healthcare administration or business preferred. Five years of experience in oncology services with active administrative/management experience strongly preferred. Candidate must have broad and intensive knowledge of hospital administration and allied health and must be very knowledgeable about the clinical needs of the cancer patient and his/her family.
