Responsible for maintaining quality services and public relations, meeting financial goals and widening the referral base of the Cancer Program. In addition, the Director is responsible for integrating and developing a comprehensive cancer program encompassing medical oncology, radiation oncology, pain management, surgical interventions and other treatment therapies to deliver the highest service to patients. Other required duties include quantifying and improving patient satisfaction, employee satisfaction and measuring quality of services delivered.

Minimum requirements include 5 years in a responsible position demonstrating management, program development and implementation of Oncology-related services. Bachelor's Degree in Nursing, Business, Allied Health or Health Care Administration is required. Experience in planning, design and implementation of new services and construction is desired.
