Position Summary:

The Medical Director has direct responsibility for the quality of medical care provided and medical staff relationships at MultiCare Deaconess Hospital (MDH) and Rockwood Clinic (MRC). This position provides administrative medical leadership for clinical and business planning, clinical performance, medical quality assessment/assurance, risk management, continuing medical education and clinical research activities for the incumbent's program/departmental area. The incumbent works in partnership with the operational leadership in the incumbent's program/departmental area and provides leadership to achieve strategic objectives, integrating those achievements with the objectives of MultiCare Health System (MHS). The incumbent works collaboratively with MHS & MRC administrative leadership teams, frontline medical leadership, and the incumbent's provider constituency and in a team-oriented approach to planning and operations and serves as a key link between MHS, the Rockwood Clinic (MRC) provider community, and the public at large as it relates to the incumbent's primary program/departmental area. This position shall perform medical director duties at the FTE identified in the employment agreement, with the balance of the activities being in direct clinical care.

This position requires the development of critical relationships through broad ranging internal and external contacts to support MHS-MDH and MRC's position as a regional center for patient care. External contacts include, among others, private physician groups, other regional health care systems, University of Washington Medical School, Washington State University College of Medicine, regional and national organizations involved in the care of patients within the incumbent's primary program/departmental area, national, state, and local regulatory agencies, and competing organizations. Internal contacts include all levels of staff and management across MHS.

- Board certified in oncology
- Minimum of 3-5 years clinical experience providing direct patient care
- Experience in a medical leadership role required
- Credentialed to practice in MultiCare Health System facilities

Minimum Requirements:

- Knowledge of health care law, health care legislation, and regulatory standards (HEDIS, JCAHO, NCQA)
- Knowledge of basic budget development, finance, and accounting necessary for operations oversight
- Knowledge of the principles of information management in order to effectively analyze data and make decisions
- Knowledge of leadership, management, and quality/performance improvement concepts and their application in an acute care and ambulatory environment
- Clinical expertise in medical (oncology), radiation oncology and/or surgical specialty
- Skill in directing the work and activities of staff with the ability to effectively delegate
- Skill in providing leadership and in mentoring
- Skill in good interpersonal, oral, and written communications
- Skill in time management
- Ability to establish a climate to achieve optimal performance levels
- Ability to build and develop a team and create a service-oriented culture
- Ability to work efficiently under pressure
